LEAP offers a formal 12-week Pre-entry ESOL course that also provides Information, Advice & Guidance sessions, signposts clients & supports them in finding volunteering or other progression opportunities.

There is also complementary informal language learning via social activities including Conversation Clubs, dancing & cooking sessions.

LEAP is targeted at clients from long established communities that have little English but want to develop this skill for everyday life, such as for talking to a GP or their child's teacher. They must not be in work.

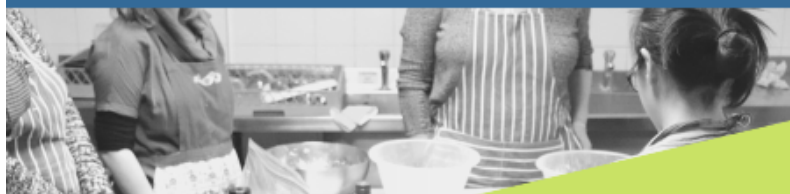

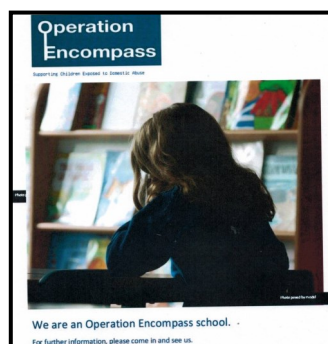
