## English in the Primary School

A Family Learning course for parents

These free sessions are for parents/carers with children in Nursery, Reception, Year 1, Year 2 or Year 3.

We will:

- Find out how your children are taught to read in school
- Learn phonics words and phrases your children use in school, such as 'blending' and 'CVC'
- Look at other areas of the curriculum such as grammar, punctuation, spelling and handwriting
- Give you free resources and suggestions of games /apps your children can play

**Where:** There are 2 English courses this Spring Term, both lasting around 60 mins:  
- An online course to download to watch wherever and whenever suits you  
- A live, interactive online course delivered by a tutor 9.30am on Thursdays
