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## Coventry FLU vaccination Catch up clinic

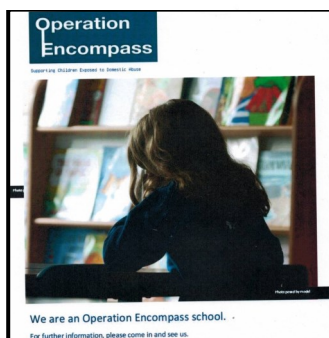

Spring term is from 6th January 2020 to 9th April 2020.

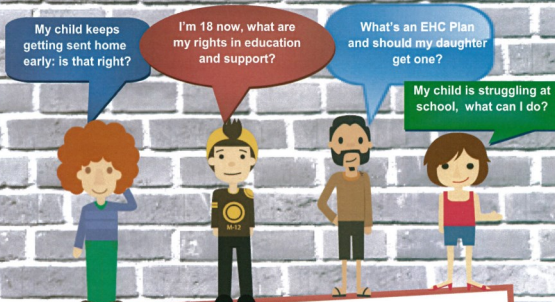
The half term break is from Saturday 22nd February 2020 to Sunday 1st March 2020 children are to return to school on Monday 2nd March 2020.
