#### English

#### Mathematics

In mathematics we have been looking at measurement, time and area and perimeter.

Some groups in year 6 have had fun weighing out and measuring different items and using their skills to read scales and convert different units of measure.

### Science





Our science topic this term has been looking at living things and their habitats. We have looked at different species of animal and classified them into different categories based on their features and characteristics. We also looked at microorganisms during this topic and looked at how mould grows. We've learned about the different types of fungi and bacteria and how some of them can be helpful to us.

#### PE
