# Nursery Newsletter



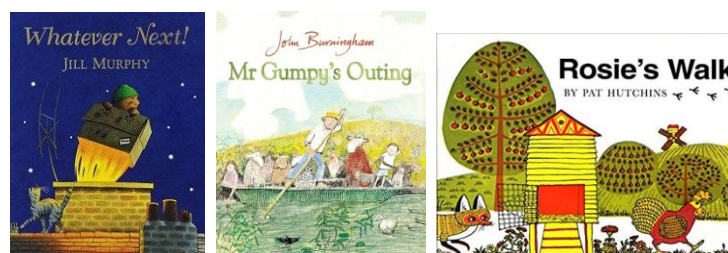
We cannot believe it is already the end of this academic year! The children are getting ready for their Reception class. They have really enjoyed their learning experience this year.

## Literacy

During this term, the children have had regular phonics lessons. The focus has been the initial sounds in words. They have also been practising letter formation.



This term the children have read some amazing story books: *Whatever Next!*, *Mr. Gumpy's Outing* and *Rosie's Walk*. The children have enjoyed listening to stories, retelling and enacting stories using props. Please share books with your child on a regular basis.



## Maths

This term children practised their counting skills through various activities. The children also learnt to create their own repeated patterns using 2D shapes and different objects. They enjoyed using iPads to play number and shape games.



## Understanding the World: The World

This term the children have learnt about the Apollo 11 space mission. They were especially excited to watch Neil Armstrong taking his first steps walking on the moon. The children also learnt to operate Bee-Bots (child-friendly robots). They have been using Bee-Bots to learn about directional language (left, right, forward, backward).
