



Nursery Newsletter



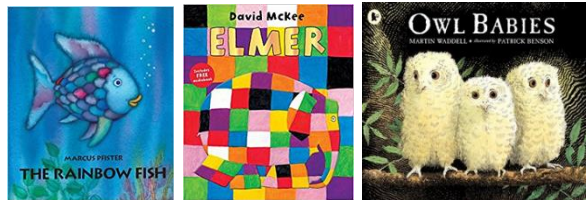
It's been a busy half-term and the children have enjoyed their learning. They looked amazing on World Book Day dressed up as their favourite book characters.
