Spring 2 –2018
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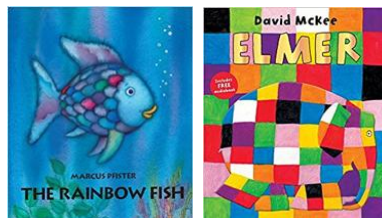

During this term the children have had regular phonic lessons. The focus has been the initial sounds in words. The children have been practising writing their names.

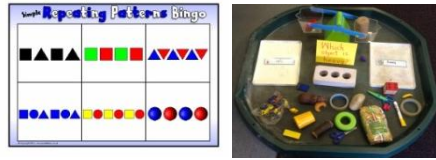
