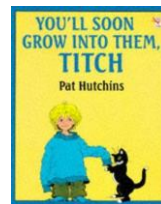
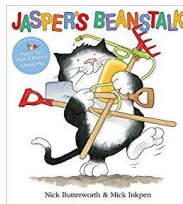
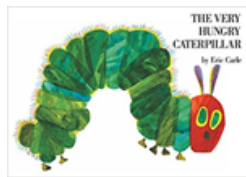
This term we have continued to focus on developing the children's communication and language skills as they are vital for their learning and development. Without these skills, they will not reach their full potential.

Literacy

During this term the children have been practising correct letter formation. They have practised writing letters in sand, shaving foam and corn flour.

This term the children have read some amazing story books: *The Very Hungry Caterpillar*, *Jasper's Beanstalk* and *You'll Soon Grow into Them, Titch*. Maths

This term we have focused on matching numerals 1- 10 with their corresponding quantities. The children have also been measuring and comparing the length and height of objects using non-standard units of measurement.

Understanding the World: The World

As our theme for this term was "growing", we have looked at the life cycles of butterflies, plants and humans. To enthuse our children, we looked after five caterpillars and watched them turn into beautiful butterflies over the period of three weeks. We have also planted various seeds (cress, sunflower and runner beans), and watched them grow. The children have also enjoyed looking at their baby photographs and have discussed how they have changed and developed since then.
