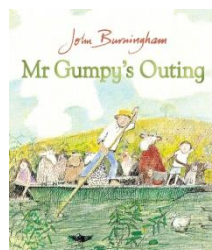
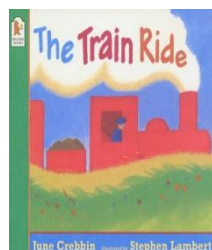
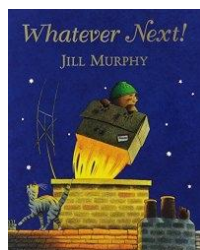
As we believe that all children should be confident speakers, this term we have continued to focus on developing children's language and communication skills. These skills are essential to enhance children's cognitive development.

Literacy

During this term, the children have had regular phonics lessons. The focus has been the initial sounds in words.

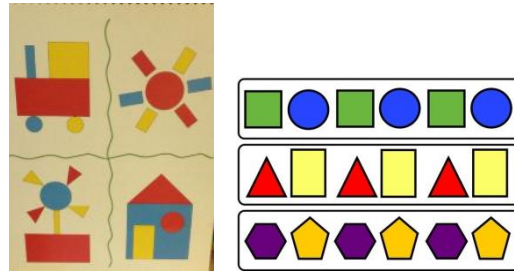

Maths
