All children will continue to work on these skills next term and practice using them to spell words and write CVC/CVCC words. We are still practicising our tricky words; I, no, go, to, you, he, she, me, the, said, my, are, come, some, your.

In Autumn I the children have been reading some fantastic books. We have read Elmer and Handa's Surprise. They have really enjoyed learning new words, learning to retell the story in order and repeating phrases from the story.



## Maths

In Maths the children have been recognising and writing numbers to 10 and beyond. We have also learnt the names and properties of 2D shapes. In the final week of this term we have been creating our own repeated patterns using shapes and colours.
