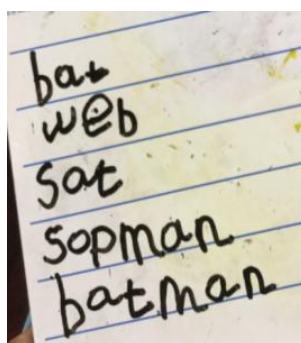

The Reception Children have been working really hard on their phonics this term and have now finished all of their set 1 sounds! All children will continue to work on these sounds next term and practice using them to spell words and to write simple sentences. We have also been working hard on our action words; mum, dad, my, said, you, I, he, she, no, can, yes, am, going, to and are.

Reading – amazing books!

This term the children have read some amazing books; The Three Little Pigs, Elmer, Room On The Broom, Rosie's Walk, Aliens Love Underpants. They have really enjoyed learning new words, exploring different settings (jungle, space), acting out the stories through role play and creating story maps to extend their learning.



Maths

In Maths the children have been working on their counting to 10 and beyond. They have learnt how to count accurately and are continuing to work on their problem solving skills related to this. We have also been learning about 2D shapes and their properties, we have drawn them, made models and have been describing them. Next term we will be continuing to work on shape focussing on 3D shapes, as well as learning about the size and weight of objects.

Knowledge & Understanding of the World

The children have learnt about different celebrations this term; Harvest Festival, Diwali, Halloween, Children in Need, Remembrance Day, Bonfire Night. They have looked at different religions and customs and why they celebrate different festivals. They have also had the opportunity to make and taste some foods and dress up for these as well as creating their own art to celebrate each one.
