What have we been learning?

They have worked extremely hard to learn about lots of new topics and have undertaken a wide range of enjoyable but challenging activities with a positive growth mindset.

English

Children have studied poetry and 'Night Zoo Keeper'. Within their English lessons they have covered a large range of features which include language features a well as text features. They have been extremely busy writing a character descriptions and narratives. The standard of writing has been high. Children are showing increasing confidence in using expanded noun phrases, fronted adverbials and a range of conjunctions to give reasoning for their ideas.

Maths

In Maths children have been focusing on all four operations. They have studied addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Children have also shown a great understanding of their 2, 5 and 10 number sequences. They have been working hard on money recognising the value of coins and making amounts of money with those coins. In measurement they are continuing to extend the range of times they can read and recognise beyond o'clock times and half past and are starting to work on quarter to and quarter past



Science



They have been learning about the different parts of the animal kingdom. Children can identify animals from different groups such as mammals, birds, fish etc. and can label body parts of different types of animals. They have been finding out about human senses including sight, hearing and taste.

Geography

They have been learning about the coast and seaside developing and understanding of what the coast is how humans use coastal environments and the difference between human and natural features of an environment.
