



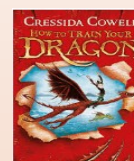
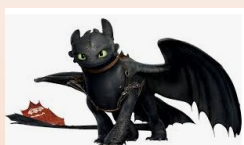
The **Year 3** team consists of our teachers: Mrs Davies , Mrs Begum and TAs Mrs Kaczor, and Mrs Dhasi.



As part of our Art curriculum children have been exploring art and sculpture in Ancient Greece in particular pottery.. Children have a looked at the different styles of sculptures there are, the materials used and the designs created on them. As well as this pupils have had the opportunity to practise techniques using clay using their hands and also specific clay tools. These new skills have then been used to create a piece of fabulous sculpture for the Year 3 art gallery.

English

This term pupils have been exploring the text How To Train Your Dragon. Pupils have explored the different features used in the text such as expanded noun phrases, fronted adverbials and conjunctions. With this in depth exploration of the text structure pupils have then been able to write their own version of the story!



French

In French we have been learning the French story Les Quatre Amis (The Four Friends), This story has helped the children learn how to talk about animals and describe their colour and movement.

Maths

This term children have looked addition and subtraction and have been using number lines, column method, and decomposition method. We have also looked at and division. We have been using grid method, arrays and bus stop method to support us in our working out.
