## Year 3 Newsletter



*Greetings, this letter is to inform you about the Year 3's education over the Autumn term.*

### English

In English we continued with our topic of Charlie and The Chocolate Factory. We wrote a biography for Willy Wonka and created advertisement scripts for our own inventions. The children enjoyed finding out about Willy Wonka's interesting life and acting out scripts they created themselves.



### Mathematics

In Mathematics, we have been looking at different types of measurement (time, capacity, weight) and geometry. The children have enjoyed learning about these topics as they were challenged. The children had great fun making parallel and perpendicular lines on the playground and they are now able to identify them. The children have also been looking at the properties of 2D and 3D shapes. They were able to use the correct mathematical vocabulary in their work.



### Science

The topic for science was Animals, Including Humans. The main focus was on food groups, skeletons and muscles. The children enjoyed learning about how their own bodies work and different ways animals can be grouped.

### P.E

This half term we have been doing Hockey. We have been learning how to stand and how to hold the stick correctly. We have also worked on the push pass and shoot.

The children have really enjoyed doing Hockey and week on week have improved their skills and confidence.

### R.E

For R.E, we have looked at sacred books from different religions such as the Bible, Quran and Torah. The children enjoyed learning about how these books are an important guide for different religions.



### History

In History, we have been looking at Kings and Queens over time in Britain. So far the children have really enjoyed learning about Henry VIII and his 6 wives. The children enjoyed making their news broadcasts about how the wives died. We have also begun to look at Queen Victoria and the children will soon be writing a letter to the Queen!

### Computing

In computing we have been looking at cookery shows. The children enjoyed creating their own script for a cookery show which they then role played and recorded.



### French

This half term in French, the children have been looking at how to introduce themselves, ask simple questions and confidently count up to 20 in French. On French Day, the children were greeted by two French visitors who had put on a fun showbiz show for us. The children had fun joining in with the show and putting their French knowledge to use!

We are very proud of the children this term.

### Home Learning

In our Year 3 home learning we have been revising: Mathematics, English and reading skills. This has helped us consolidate our learning and become better learners.
