Maths

This Term, we have looked into further developing our knowledge of fractions and space, shape and measure; subsequently applying these in problemsolving and reasoning contexts. We have noticed a fantastic improvement in children's ability to use and apply their mathematical knowledge to problemsolving and this has been reflected in some brilliant scores during assessment week!

Science

In Science, we have been exploring space! This has provided some great opportunities to learn about the planets, moon and sun,

in addition to considering the role and lifestyle of astronauts. We have conduted a balloon rocket experiment and have also designed our own space land spacesuits.

English

This term we have split our learning across two key genres: first, a description of an alien planet and then returning to creating a narrative regarding the character of Ali-E; a lonely alien stranded on a garbage planet. These two themes have provided a wonderful basis upon which to build the children's understanding of story-telling, language choices and punctuation. We have also been able to develop our understanding of descriptive devices such as expanded noun phrases and relative clauses.

Summer Term 2: Foundation Subjects

Computing

This half term, the children have been Vloggers; learning how to research, source and prepare to create a Vlog (Video Blog) on a topic of our choosing. From storing, manipulating and subsequently creating content, the children have all been able to use search engines safely and appropriately and retrieve content which they have then been able to use and apply in their finished products.



Art

In Art, the children have been looking at recreating work of different styles. This has taken the form of sketching but also using different materials such as charcoal for a range of purposes such as shading and shadowing.

History

This half-Term, we have been looking at the Romans. This has allowed us to gain a greater understanding of the history of Britain in researching things such as Roman roads, gods and goddesses and the story of Boudicca. We supplemented our learning with a trip to the Lunt Roman Fort near Bagington, Coventry wherein the children were able to learn, interact with and act in the environment as Romans (and Celts!) for the day.



PSHCEE

We have been using our P4C to discuss a range of social, emotional and personal issues and topics. The children have been able to build upon their discussion skills but also learn how to work philosophically in their scaffolding, construction and debate of questions and ideas.

Physical Education

On Wednesdays, 3D have been going to the AT7 Centre to take part in swimming lessons. Miss Dhothar and Miss Kaczor are so proud of the way in which the children have represented our school and class and are delighted with the progress they have made. Meanwhile in 3C, the children have been taking part in Yoga to calm the body and mind and also football!

Religious Education



We have been learning about processes and prayer in Christianity, Judaism, Hinduism and Islam.
