What have we been learning?

Wow what an exciting term this has been! First, we have been practicing hard for our Multiplication Check Test which Year 4 has done really well on. We would like to thank all parents that have assisted their children with their times tables and a well done to all the Year 4 children. Well done, 4G! Towards the end of the term some children from Year 4 participated in some exciting workshops for both Maths and English where they engaged in different activities to chal-



lenge their learning in Maths and English.

English

In English, we have learnt about traditional tales. The children have enjoyed creating their own fairytale stories with twists! For example, the Three Little Mice. We have enjoyed reading 'The Lost Happy Endings' and using all the features we learnt to retell the story. We have learnt and applied many features such as expanded noun phrases, similes, fronted adverbials and relative clauses. The children created some amazing stories! We then wrote a diary entry from the main character's point of view.

Allow your children the chance to write their own diary entries to record their feelings and thoughts and apply what they have learnt in their English lessons.

Maths

In Maths, we have been consolidating our learning across different topics. We have practiced and mastered addition, subtraction, multiplication and division written strategies. We also have been learning about plotting coordinates to create polygons, converting measurements, mass and weight, and shapes.



Science

In Science, we have been learning about electricity. We first looked at what electricity is and how we use it in our everyday life. We learnt that electricity is integrated in everything we do! We looked at circuits, how to build them and recognize the different symbols. We enjoyed investigating how the number of batteries affected the brightness of the bulb and we all loved creating our own cell. The children have loved and engaged well with this topic and have enjoyed learning all about electricity.

Design and technology (D&T):

In D&T, we have been investigating wire loop games and creating our own game. First, we designed our game and then we created the loop using wire. To make the game work we used our knowledge from Science to create a circuit. It was an amazing experience to create our own game!
