Well done to all of Year 4 who have been working exceptionally hard to get 10/10 every week in their spelling test! Please continue to practise for our test on Friday's.



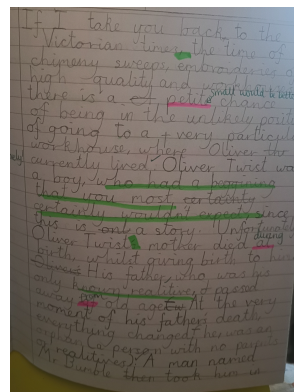
Home Learning is given out Every Friday. It must be returned to school by Wednesday.

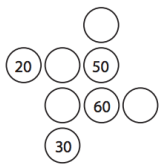
Maths
