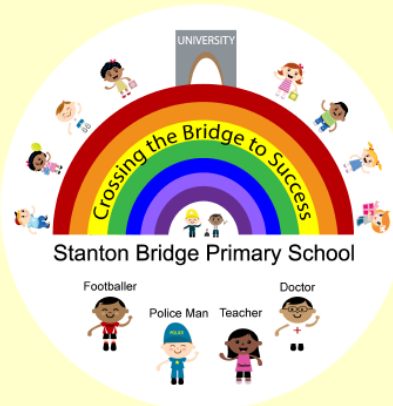

Year 6 Newsletter

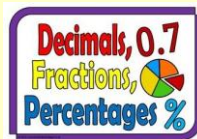
Greetings, this letter is to inform you about the year six's education over the Autumn term.
