Uniform Policy 2017-2019

Uniform requirements

School uniform is very important at Stanton Bridge Primary School so that pupils feel part of the school community and take pride in their appearance. We expect all children to be smartly dressed in the correct uniform. Families will be notified if a child is not in the correct uniform and asked to bring in appropriate clothing and/or footwear.

Boys should wear:

- Black or Grey Trousers
- Black School Shoes - no trainers permitted
- White Shirt or polo shirt
- Black or Grey Socks
- School Sweatshirt



Girls should wear:

- Grey or black school skirt or trousers
- Red summer dress
- Flat Black School Shoes - no trainers or sandals permitted
- White Shirt or polo shirt
- White, Grey or black Socks or Tights
- School Sweatshirt or cardigan
- Plain red, black or white School Headscarf

PE Kit

PE kit is the same for all pupils and should be kept in an appropriate, named bag.

- Black jogging bottoms or shorts
- White polo shirt
- Plain black pumps
- White, red or black bandana style headscarf (avoiding the neck area)



NO commercial football kits should be worn for PE.

Sensible hairstyles should be worn for school - no "fashion statements" such as coloured hair, shaved in lines or styles such as Mohican.

Jewellery should be kept minimal, if worn, earrings should be small studs.

Please make sure that all items of clothing are clearly marked with your child's name.
