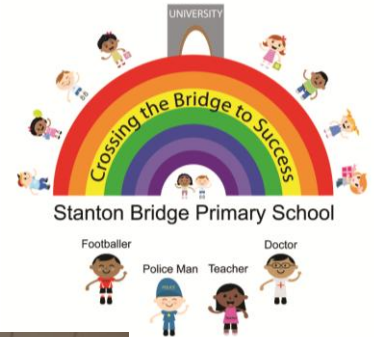

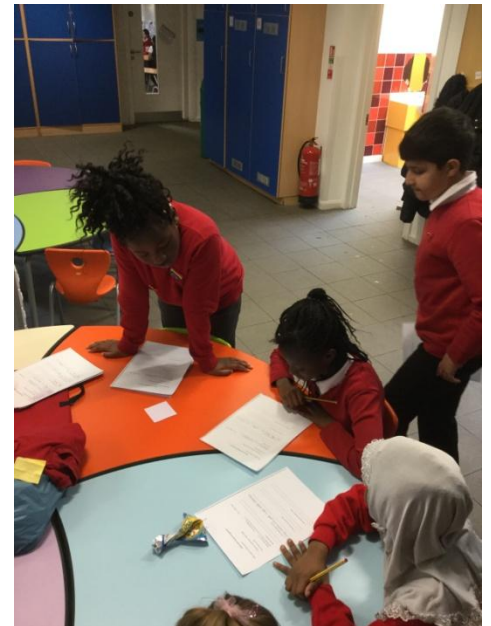

- We sometimes work in small groups and take part in interventions.



# How do we support and care for each other?
