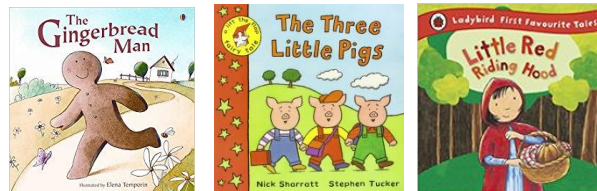


We have approached the end of Spring!! The children have enjoyed their learning this term.

Literacy

During this term the children have had regular Phase 1 phonics lessons. Phase 1 concentrates on speaking and listening skills in order to attune them to the sounds around them and to get them ready to develop blending and oral segmenting skills. Additionally, the children have been practising writing their names.

This term the children have also read three amazing story books: The Gingerbread Man, The Three Little Pigs and Little Red Riding Hood. The children have liked listening to stories, retelling and enacting stories using props. They have also enjoyed creating superheroes using a variety of vegetables. Please regularly share books with your child.



Maths

In Maths, the children have been learning about numbers and 2D shapes. The children are learning to recite numbers in order (1-10), count with one-to-one corresponding and match numerals and quantities correctly. They have also enjoyed playing Maths games on iPads. Furthermore, the children have been learning to create pictures with shapes.

Physical Development: Health and Self-care

This term the children have been learning about healthy eating. They made and tasted fruit kebabs. This term children have also started having PE lessons which they are thoroughly enjoying.
