

# Nursery Newsletter

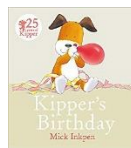


The children are well-settled in nursery, and are enjoying their learning experience. They have been learning to be independent by putting their coats on by themselves and tidying up after play.

## Literacy

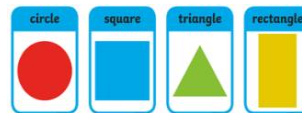
During this term, the children have been introduced to Phase 1 of phonics programme. In Phase 1, the emphasis is on developing children's speaking and listening skills. The children have also worked hard to learn to recognise and write their names.

This term the children have enjoyed reading some amazing story books: Bully, Kipper's Birthday and Dear Santa. They have liked listening to and re-enacting stories using props. Please share books with your child on a regular basis.



## Maths

In Maths the children have been learning about numbers (1-5). They have been learning to rote count and counting objects in various contexts. This term the children have also learnt about basic 2D shapes. They have started to notice shapes in their environment. Additionally, the children have used 2D shapes to create pictures.



## Understanding the World

This term the children have learnt about different festivals such as Diwali, Bonfire Night and Christmas. They have enjoyed engaging in different celebrations. We had a visit from Father Christmas and his elf. The children were very excited to see Santa.
