This week, pupils have been taking part in some amazing experiences designed to further develop their understanding of the history curriculum and had great fun at the same time!

Year 3 took part in a workshop all about the Ancient Greeks—they dressed up in traditional clothing and learnt all about daily life as it would have been lived in the past.
