Attendance Race




The results for Autumn Term 1, week 1

- In 2022 almost a quarter of all A Levels awarded to King Henry VIII pupils were A*s, over half were A* or A and close to 80% were B grade or higher the best results in Coventry!
- Of the 983 GCSE exams undertaken by our students in 2022, an astonishing 272 were awarded Grade 9 and over half were Grade 8 or 9
- With its origins in the Benedictine priory established by Earl Leofric and Lady Godiva, and refounded in 1545 under the instruction of King Henry VIII, our school has been part of the fabric of Coventry for much of its history
- In addition to a wide network of school shuttle buses, King Henry VIII lies on several public bus routes and is just a two-minute walk from Coventry station
