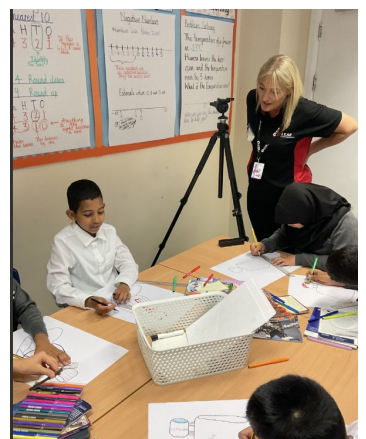
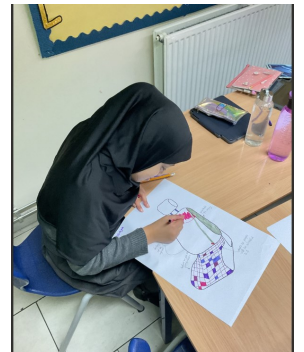
World Mental Health Day
