Dear Parents/Carers,

This week we reopened the Crabmill Lane gate to allow both entrance and exit to the school premises. Many parents have expressed their appreciation and we are so pleased that the lower rates of infection have allowed us to do this.

I must however remind you all that you **MUST** remember to stick to your right hand side when using this entrance. This forms part of our risk assessment in being able to re-open the gates as a two way system, should parents not follow this, we will be forced to close it again.

Whilst Government restrictions are being relaxed, it is now even more important to ensure we are all following the guidance. If your child, or anyone in your household is showing symptoms of Covid-19, you **MUST** all isolate whilst waiting for your test result. In order to keep pupils, family members and staff safe you must inform school immediately of anyone with symptoms or a positive test result. We will ensure that all pupils who are isolating for 10 days are provided with work books and online learning whilst they are not in school.

We thank you all for your continued support and in following the guidance - it is through us working together that we will keep each other as safe as we possibly can.

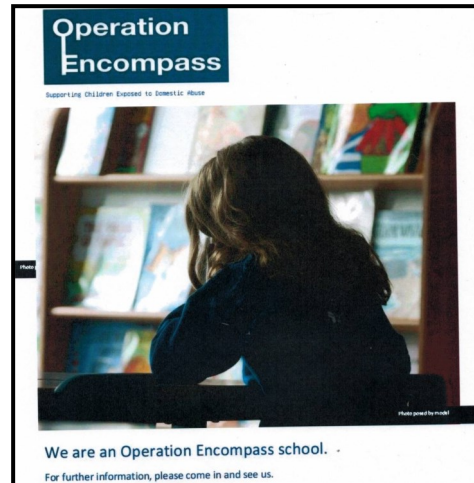
The issue is not just about children's competence with numeracy, it is about their confidence and **attitude** towards the subject too.
