Remember PRIZES can be won, a free entry into the prize draw every time you buy a book.



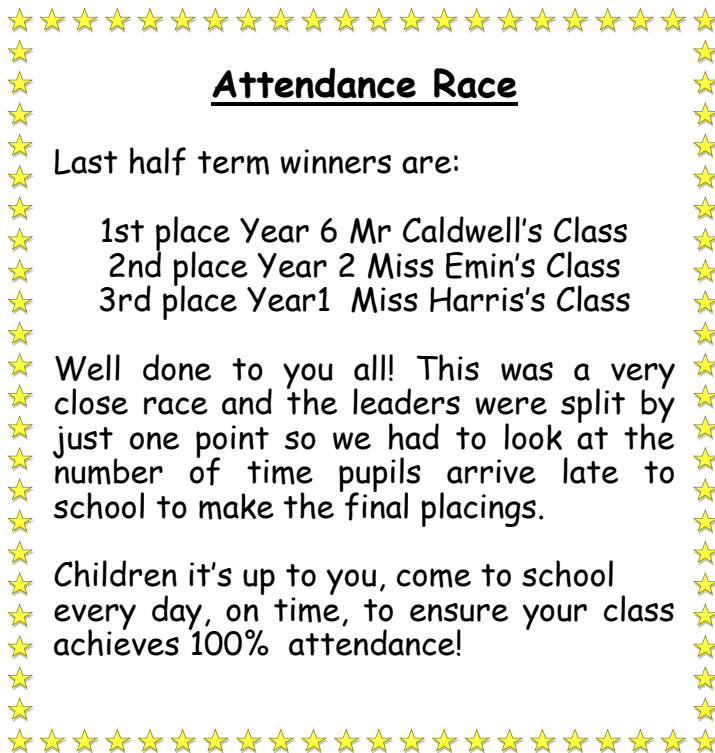
## Attendance Race

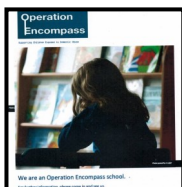
