We will be running a range of fun activities including developing basic skills in Maths and English.

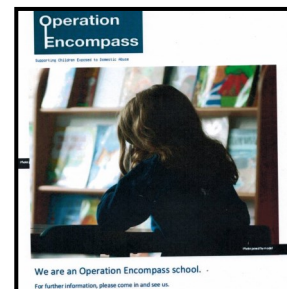
If you would like to book a space for your child/children in advance, please let Mr T know. More details including dates and timings of the Summer Holiday Clubs will be given out in a few weeks.
