Autumn half term begins on Saturday 23rd October 2021 to Sunday 31st October 2021


Teacher training days: Monday 1st and Tuesday 2nd of November 2021. Children return to school after half term on Wednesday 3rd November 2021
















October Half Term at Coventry Museums
