From the Head Teacher

Dear Parents/Carers,

Unfortunately, this week has seen an increase in the number of staff and pupils who have tested positive for Covid-19. We have many more who have symptoms and are waiting for test results. In order to enable us to keep school open, it is a **MUST** that our whole school community maintains **strict distancing, use of face coverings and regular testing.**

You will have seen this week that we invited a Covid testing site to our school grounds to offer free testing for both parents and pupils—thank you to all those who took the opportunity to test themselves. We were the first primary school in the area to offer this service directly to our school community and will be asking them to return on a regular basis.. We urge all of our parents to take advantage of this service, regardless of your vaccination status or whether you or your children are showing symptoms. The only way we will be able to prevent bubbles closing is if we work together to ensure we identify symptoms and positive cases early.

We have been directed by Public Health England to inform parents that if any member of their household shows symptoms or tests positive, all siblings should also isolate in order to stop the spread. Should this be the case, we will provide work books for pupils to complete whilst isolating.

Due to the increased number of cases in school, we have had to make the difficult decision to postpone the Year 4 London trip to later in the academic year. Whilst we know this is disappointing for the whole of Year 4, the safety of our pupils and staff is our top priority.

Have a lovely weekend, please stay safe and make sure to inform school as soon as possible should any members of the family begin to feel unwell.

Stanton Bridge school does it again. Not only did we have a fantastic fun day wearing our pyjamas but we raised a grand total of £305.20.

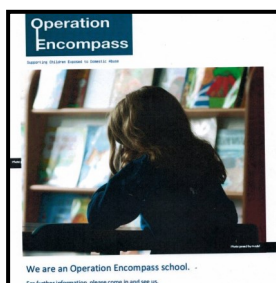
Attendance Race
