Covid

We begin the new term with the news that the Covid transmission rates in Coventry and across the country are high and increasing day on day.

We will continue to follow Local Authority and Public Health England guidance to schools to try to keep our school community as safe as possible.

For this reason, the one-way system and wearing of face coverings will remain whilst on the school grounds.

We will be working closely with the local testing team to provide opportunities for our families to get free lateral flow tests—please look out for a letter about this coming home with your children.

Please be vigilant, maintain social distance and wash/sanitise hands regularly to help control the spread of the virus.

In cases where pupils are isolating, we will still be providing work books for them to complete whilst at home—this will be organised via the front office. Where a bubble has to close, all pupils will be expected to access the remote learning in place for them.

Punctuality



Towards the end of last term, we began to see increasing numbers of pupils who were arriving late to school. It is essential that pupils are punctual every day. Arriving late means that they miss the beginning of their first lesson, this is when the teacher imparts knowledge that will be needed for the learning to take place.

The older pupils particularly, often feel anxious and worried if they are late to class and these feelings will have a detrimental impact on their readiness to learn throughout the whole day.

Please help to support us and your children by ensuring that they are in the playground ready to go into class on time. The playground gates close at 8:45am—any pupils arriving after this time will be recorded as late.
