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Health Projects

We offer a range of health projects across Coventry to reduce health inequalities facing women, with specialist support for BAME (Black and Minority Ethnic women).

MAMTA

South Warwickshire NHS Foundation Trust

MAMTA is a Child and Maternal Health service in conjunction with South Warwickshire Foundation Trust (SWFT) #FHLS in partnership with UHCW maternity services. MAMTA empowers & supports BAME women in pregnancy and after the baby is born.

BAME Cervical Screening Project

Coventry and Warwickshire NHS Central Commissioning Group

FWT is working to improve cervical screening uptake within women aged 25-64. Our project supports BAME women to overcome fears and barriers around attending Breast, Bowel and Cervical Screening. We work closely across GP surgeries and outreach venues.

Perinatal Mental Health BAME Peer Support

Coventry and Warwickshire NHS Partnership

The Perinatal Mental Health BME Peer Support Project aims to educate and support BAME women through the antenatal and postnatal period around their emotional wellbeing.
