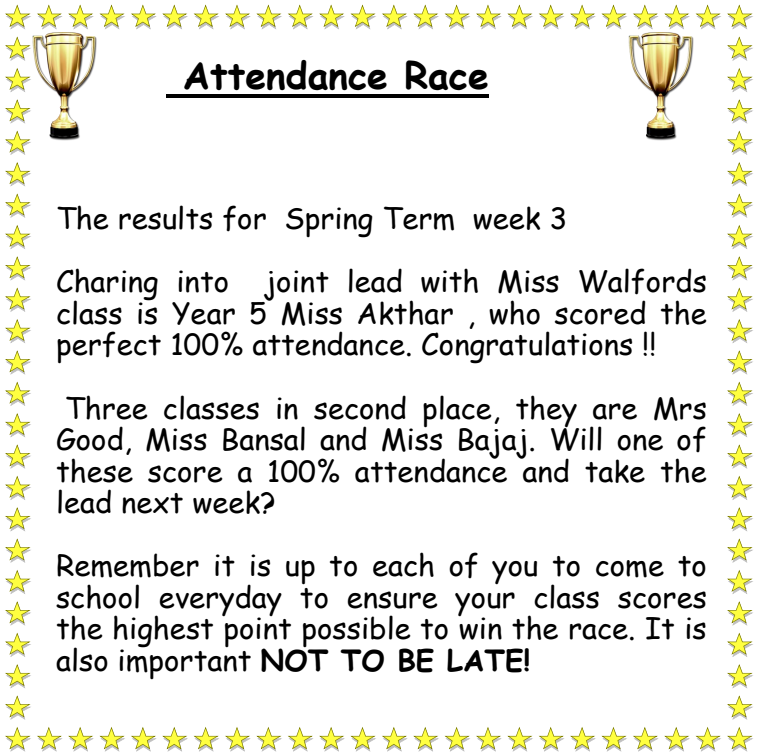


Diary Dates

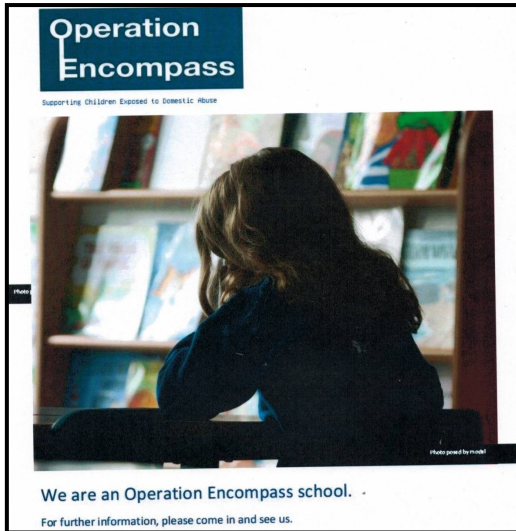
