Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you to all of the parents and carers who attended our meeting this week, and to those working parents who called into school to let us know that they could not attend the meeting - we are organising a suitable time to meet with you after May half term. We are grateful to all those parents who left us feedback, we have included some of your suggestions below along with a response.

You suggested: We run 'virtual meetings' for pupils to access one to one feedback online. We certainly have the ability to run virtual meetings using Showbie, these rely on parents ensuring that all pupils are logged in on an appropriate device that has working audio and a microphone. Often this means that the session is delayed and learning time is lost, however virtual sessions may be arranged where necessary.

You suggested: Hold a trial period of the new timings and then hold a second consultation. This is our intention - the trial period will run for the final half of summer term to be evaluated ready for September.

You suggested: 1 to 1 feedback to start with year 4. This will remain under review and consideration for the future.
