Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term the children have been introduced to 'Achievosaurus'. It is an approach which helps young children to reflect on their learning and develop skills needed to become life-long learners. Please talk to children about 'Shareonyx', 'Tryatops' and 'Explorosaur'.



Literacy

In autumn 1, our topic was nursery rhymes. The children have enjoyed singing nursery rhymes using props, both individually and in a group. They had fun doing nursery rhyme related art and craft activities. This term, we have also introduced phonics phase 1 activities which focus on developing children's speaking and listening skills.



Maths

In Maths the children are learning to recite number 1-10, and counting objects in meaningful contexts. Additionally, the children have been learning to sort objects according to their colour and size.



Understanding the World

This term we have been learning about each other. In small groups, we talked about our favourite colour, fruit and animal. We have also been exploring our environment by going on listening walks.
