It must be returned to school by Wednesday.

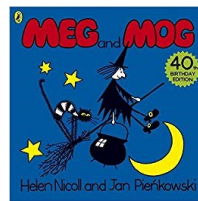
If your child needs any help or support then please let the teacher know.

What have we been learning?

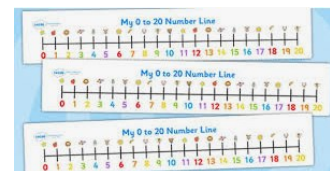
English
