




Lunch Time

Please put dinner money in an envelope with your child's name and class on it. Write the days they are having dinner.








Friday Tuck Shop

Friday tuck shop day, they can buy snacks, so don't forget to give them some money!








In the classroom

Your child in their classroom will have their own seat, a pillow case behind their chair, which they will place all their personal belongings in, e.g. learning equipment and exercise books for each subject, that they will write in.









Due to Covid-19:

- Most lessons will be taught by you child's class teacher in their classroom.
- PE will be in the hall or on the playground and taught by the PE coach.
- Children in years 3 to 6 will learn French as a Modern Foreign Language.
- Children will be assessed against the objectives of their year group.

Due to Covid-19:

Spark sessions may resume after October half term.

- For years 2 to 6, 'Spark' sessions are held once a week in the afternoon.
- During this time every available space is used and the school is buzzing with excitement.
- Children join courses that reflect their interest.
- Courses include design and crafts, woodwork, care in the local community, languages, mindfulness and a variety of sports activities.



Additional Support






- At Stanton Bridge Primary we have a variety of support mechanisms in place to help pupils reach their potential.

Outstanding Behaviour



At Stanton Bridge Primary have 'Outstanding behaviour' and we follow the 'Good to be Green' scheme, which is an effective way of promoting positive behaviour.

Protocol of Good to be Green:

- 1. Verbal Reminder/ Teacher look
- 2. Verbal Warning (Turn card over)
- 3. Move to another place in the classroom (Yellow card)
- 4. Move to partner class (Red Card)
- 5. Sent to Learning Mentor/SLT
- 6. Reported to Mrs. Islam






Assemblies



- Everyday our children are fortunate enough to enjoy a whole school assembly. Due to Covid-19, assemblies will be in class until further notice.
- These assemblies are linked in to PSHCEE and citizenship and cover many broad topics, which encourage children to reflect about themselves and the world around us.
- We are a multi cultural school and aim to ensure our assemblies include reflections of lots of different ideas, cultures and faiths whilst encouraging our shared values of respect and democracy.
- We also celebrate children's successes, through 'Star of the Week' and 'Lucky Children' Awards.







- After October half term children may also take home reading books from the class and school library.
- We have a 100 book challenge your child will join in with and get lots of Awards.













 We use Reading Eggs which is an online, interactive tool used to teach reading across Reception, Key Stage I. Reading Eggspress is used across Key Stage 2 to develop reading comprehension skills.

 Both Reading Eggs and Reading Eggspress are used in school to develop reading as part of weekly homework tasks.


Your child will have login details and a password.

- We use Times Tables Rock Stars for years I to 6 to practise different times tables. It is also set as homework.
- This supports the children to recall their timetables with speed.
- Your child will have login details and a password. These should remain confidential and allow you and your child unique access.



• In Year 4 all children must know their 12x Tables off by heart and be ready for the National timestable tests.







- We use Purple Mash, which is a creative educational website for children.
- Purple Mash is a cross-curricular resource covering art to science and all subjects in between. As well as using it in school, your child can access Purple Mash from home on a laptop, desktop or a tablet.
- Your child will have login details and a password. These should remain confidential and allow you and your child unique access.



Uniform & PE Kits

- You can purchase the uniform from school during the week beginning 24th August 2020.
- School uniform creates a sense of belonging, to feel part of a wider group and as one.
- We expect all children to come to school dressed in school uniform.
- PE kits need to worn during PE lessons. You will be told what day you child's PE lesson is on and you send in the PE kit on that day.
