RE

Furthermore, pupils are expected to learn their spellings in preparation for the tests they have on Fridays.

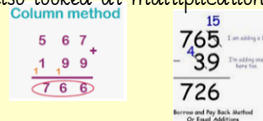
Pupils are also expected to login into Times Tables Rockstars to develop their multiplication fluency skills and Purple Mash to complete topic based activities set by their teachers.

English

This term pupils have been exploring the text 'How To Train Your Dragon'. Pupils have explored the different features used in the text such as expanded noun phrases, fronted adverbials and conjunctions. With this in depth exploration of the text structure pupils have then been able to write their own version of the story! Ask your child to re-tell their story to you.

Mathematics

This term children have looked addition and subtraction and have been using number lines, column method, and decomposition method. We have also looked at multiplication and division.



We have been using grid method, arrays and bus stop method to support us in our working out.

Science

This term pupils have been exploring the topic of 'Plants' pupils have been exploring; How they grow, what they need to grow, the different parts of a plant and the life cycles of them. They have also developed their knowledge on flowers and know the reproduction of flowers. Pupils have further investigated the conditions
