

In English we continued with our topic of Charlie and The Chocolate Factory. We created advertisement scripts for our own inventions. The children en joyed finding out about Willy Wonka's interesting life and acting out scripts they created themselves. Children were also treated to a cinema morning watching the film with a selection of beverages-as they also received golden tickets!

Mathematics

In Mathematics, we have been looking at different types of measurement (time, capacity, weight) and geometry. The children have enjoyed learning about these topics as have been developing their problem solving and reasoning skills. The children have also been looking at the properties of 2D and 3D shapes. They were able to use the correct mathematical vocabulary in their work.

<u>Science</u>

The topic for science was Animals, Including Humans. The main focus was on food groups, skeletons and muscles. The children enjoyed learning about how their own bodies work and different ways animals can be grouped. Children were also Science food detectives and explored a range of cuisine to see if they were a balanced healthy meal and explored the food packaging nutrient contents.

History



In History, we have been looking at Kings and Queens over time in Britain. So far the children have really enjoyed learning about Henry VIII and his 6 wives. The children enjoyed making their puppet show using an app about the wives. We have also begun to look at Queen Victoria and the children will soon be writing a letter to the Queen!

Computing.

In computing we have been looking at cookery shows. The children enjoyed creating their own script for a cookery show which they then role played and recorded.

Children have been busy exploring the history of the 'chicken Balti' also they created their own recipes and made a chicken and vegetarian Balti! Children understood the importance of using their mathematical skills and following instructions.
