The **Year 5** team consists of our teachers: Mr Satchwell and Miss Bowen and TAs: Miss Walford and Miss Quirke.

English

This term pupils have been studying the Jungle book and creating a narrative based on the story. We have been focussing on extending our vocabulary, developing our descriptions, using fronted adverbials and two pair sentences and using inverted commas. This week, we have started our next topic of report writing, looking at the features of a newspaper articles and how a journalist would create a report.



Maths

This term children have looked at the four operations and are moving on to study fractions. Children understand which operation to use when solving word problems. They have also been applying their knowledge to a range of problem solving activities, which the children have enjoyed. Children have been focusing on their reasoning skills and looking as real life problems involving multiplication and subtraction.

Science

In Science this term, pupils have been researching Earth and Space and learning about: the different planets, how we have day and night and different features of our solar system. In lessons, we have practically looked at how the Sun provides us with daylight and then

created diagrams to show the orbits of Earth, the Sun and Moon (Heliocentric and Geocentric). Recently, pupils enjoyed learning about the phases of the moon, click the link below to listen to the phases of the moon rap, which was a hit with both year 5 classes.
