History

#### English

This term, Year 6 have been studying 'The BFG' by Roald Dahl. We began this topic with our own cinema-style screening of the film! We then completed narratives, retelling different sections of the story. Following on from this, we wrote a narrative and invented our version of the story using different characters from the book.



#### Mathematics

In mathematics, we began the term by looking at measurement and practiced converting different units of length, mass and capacity.

We learned all about geometry. The children then looked at angles and how to draw, read and name different angles.



#### Science

Our science topic this half term has been 'electricity'. We have looked at different types of electrical circuits and learned the scientific symbols for the different components. Children investigated the impact of voltage on the brightness of a bulb and also had the opportunity to design and make their own working switches!



This half term we have being exploring the Ancient Egyptians. We learnt about the way Egyptians lived and the mummification and mummified a tomato.
