Year 6 have had an action-packed half-term and have been progressing well with their learning.

The Year 6 team consists of our teachers: Miss Cooper and Mrs Harris and TAs Mrs Faleel and Mrs Sheraz.

English

In English, we have been looking at the story of `*Journey to Jo'burg'*. We wrote a narrative, as well as a diary entry about the story. The pupils really enjoyed this text and have produced some excellent pieces of writing.

Mathematics

In mathematics, the children have been looking at fractions, decimals and percentages. They then applied their knowledge to a shopping-based investigation, which provided them with the context of how these skills can be used in real life.

The children then looked at measurement and practiced converting different units of length, mass and capacity. They also studied area and perimeter and developed their understanding of volume.

Science

Our science topic this half term has been 'electricity'. We have looked at different types of electrical circuits and learned the scientific symbols for the different components. Children investigated the impact of voltage on the brightness of a bulb and also had the opportunity to design and make their own working switches!



Art

In Art, the children have been using batik to create their own African-style patterns and masks!



History

In History, the children have been studying the Kingdom of Ancient Benin. They have enjoyed learning about the story of Eweka and discovering how the kingdom began.

SPARK!

This half-term, the children have continued to enjoy participating in their SPARK activities on Friday afternoons. Children were given the opportunity to choose a new activity in which to participate, with a wide variety of options including: sign language, entrepreneurial club, sports and animation.
