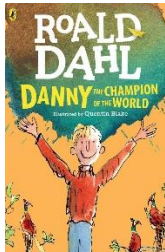

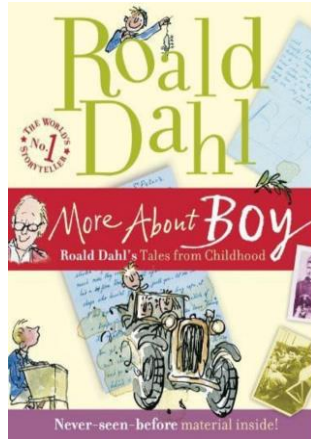


Once you have listened to the story, answer these questions on Showbie.

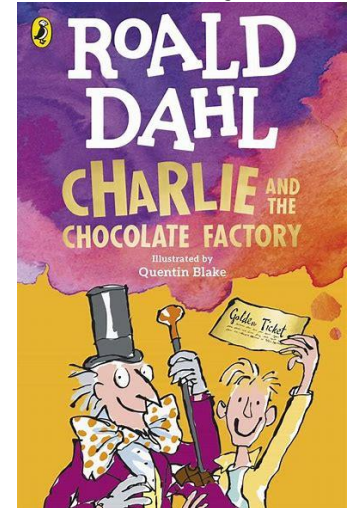

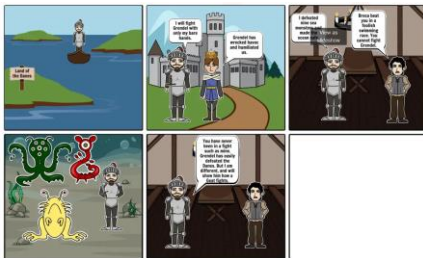
